

Message from the Kagyu Mönlam Chenmo Trust

Following the postponement of our annual gathering in Bodh Gaya due to the ongoing pandemic, the Kagyu Monlam team are happy to announce that the main Monlam puja will be conducted in Rumtek His Holiness Karmapa's **Sangha Dhuche**, together with **Nedo Chedu Chokhorling Monastery**

and

Karma Dechen Chokhorling Nunnery

. The Monlam will be audio-streamed live from Rumtek, and this live stream will be available on His Holiness's website and social media platforms, as well as the Kagyu Monlam Facebook and YouTube pages.

All students are invited to join the aspiration prayers live from Rumtek, between 16 and 23. December, from the safety of their own homes. The daily schedule will be published soon.

A recording of the prayers, which will also include a brief welcome address by Thaye Dorje, His Holiness the 17th Gyalwa Karmapa, will be available for all students who are unable to join the live stream.

In Nepal: **Ka-Nying Shedrub Ling Monastery, Dhagpo Sheydrup Ling, Karma Ngedhon Osal Choekhorling, Sangye Choeling Monastery, Nepal Buddhist Nunnery School, Sharminub Institute, Dhuldarling, Karma Raj Mahavihara, Lhundrup Ling, Nepal Trungram Gumba, Nepal Trungram Nunnery, Karma Dubgyu Chokorling, Mila Kagyu Ling Mahaboudha Gumba, Karma Theksum Choiling Monastery, Jangchub Choeling Monastery, Kagyu Institute for Buddhist Studies (Kirtipur) and Tharpa Choeling Nunnery.**
